- I. Qualification and mode of appointment will be in accordance with the existing UGC regulations, in the case of Lecturers, Readers and Professors. The qualifications for the post of Lecturer (Non-UGC) in Darusilpa will be
- i) good traditional knowledge in the subject concerned.
 - ii) Teaching experience in approved institutions.
 - iii) Desirable: Degree/Diploma from approved institution in the concerned subject.

II. **General Instructions**

- 1) Age relaxation will be admissible as per rules to SC/ST and OBC candidates. Relaxation in the upper age limit is allowed in the case of teachers already in the service of the University.
- 2) Application form can be had from the University Office by remitting the required amount (Rs.150/- for General Candidates and Rs.35/- for SC/ST candidates) towards cost of the application form in the Cash Counter. Application form can also be downloaded from the University website www.ssus.ac.in. Such applications should be accompanied by DD for Rs. 150/- for general candidates and Rs.35/- for SC/ST candidates, in addition to the registration fee. The application should be submitted in 5 sets with all documents. Demand Draft for the cost of application form and registration fee should be drawn in favour of the Finance Officer, Sree Sankaracharya University of Sanskrit, Kalady from any one of the nationalized banks, payable at Kalady. APPOINTMENT TO TEACHING POSTS

PROSPECTUS

Notification No: R.Cell/1470/SSUS/2010

Dated 20.03.2010

I. Qualifications:

a) Professor

The candidate should be an eminent scholar with published work of high quality, actively engaged in research, with 10 years of experience in post graduate teaching, and/or experience in research at the University/ National level institutions including experience of guiding research at doctoral level.

Or

An outstanding scholar with established reputation who has made significant contribution to knowledge.

b) Reader

Good academic record with a doctoral degree or equivalent published work. In addition to these, candidates who join from outside the university system, shall also possess at least 55% of the marks or an equivalent grade of B in the 7 point scale with latter grades O, A, B, C, D, E & F at the Master's Degree Level.

Five years of experience of teaching and/or research excluding the period spent for obtaining the research degrees and has made some marks in the areas of scholarship as evidenced by quality of publications, contribution to educational innovation, design of new courses and curricula.

c) Lecturer

Good academic record with at least 55 % of the marks/or, an equivalent grade of B in the 7 point scale with latter grades O,A,B,C,D,E & F at the Masters Degree Level, in the relevant subject from an Indian University, or, an equivalent degree from a foreign University. Besides fulfilling the above qualifications, candidates should have cleared the eligibility test (NET) for lecturers conduct by the UGC, CSIR or similar test accredited by the UGC.

Notes :

1. A relaxation of 5% will be provided from 55% to 50% of the marks at the Master's level for the SC/ST category.
2. A relaxation of 5% will be provided from 55% to 50% of the marks to the Ph.D degree holders who have passed their Master's degree prior to 19th September 1991.
3. B in the 7 point scale with latter grade O,A,B,C,D,E, and F shall be regarded as equivalent of 55% wherever the grading system is followed.
4. Relaxation in NET qualification will be provided as ordered by the University Grants Commission from time to time.

5. The minimum requirement of 55% shall not be insisted upon for Professor and Readers for the existing incumbents who are already in the University system. However, these marks should be insisted upon for those entering the system from outside and those at the entry point of Lecturers.
6. A relaxation of the minimum marks at the PG level from 55% to 50% for appointment as Lecturer will be provided to the candidates who have cleared the JRF examination conducted by UGC/CSIR only prior to 1989, when the minimum marks required to appear for JRF exam were 50%.

II. General Instructions

1. Age relaxation will be admissible as per rules to SC/ST and OBC candidates. Relaxation in the upper age limit is allowed in the case of teachers already in the service of the University.
2. Filled in application along with demand draft towards registration fee and all other copies of relevant certificates in proof of qualification, age, communal reservation, non-creamy layer certificate etc. should reach the undersigned on or before 20.4.2010. The cover containing filled in application form should be superscribed with "*Application for the Post of Professor/Reader/Lecturer/Lecturer (Non-UGC)-..... (subject)*".
3. Appointments will be made as per the communal rotation specified in the table. If qualified hands are not found in the concerned reservation community, the turn will be passed over to other communities as per Rule 14 to 17 of K.S.S.R. and appointment will be made, if the rule permits and the situation so demands.
4. Demand draft towards cost of application form and registration fee shall be taken from any of the nationalized Banks in favour of **the Finance Officer, Sree Sankaracharya University of Sanskrit, Kalady , payable at Kalady.**
5. As stipulated in the revised UGC regulations, applicants for the post of Professor and Reader should submit four copies of bio-data and reprint of three major publications for getting assessed by the Subject Experts in the Selection Committee. For the post of Professor, one of the publications could be a book or research report. For more details the candidates are advised to refer to the UGC Notification No.F3-1 2000 (PS) dated, 4th April 2000.
6. Persons applied for any of the posts notified earlier need not remit the registration fee, but submit application, updating the bio-data etc.
7. For the posts earmarked for SC/ST candidates, persons belonging to such category need only apply.
8. Application received late, not filled up properly and not signed by the candidates will be summarily rejected without notice.
