PROSPECTUS

1. THE UNIVERSITY

The Sree Sankaracharya University of Sanskrit was established in November 1993 by an Act of Kerala State Legislature, as an institution of higher learning, with particular focus on Sanskrit language and literature, Indology, Indian Philosophy, Indian Languages, Social Sciences and other related subjects. Kalady, the birth place of the great Indian Philosopher Adi Sankaracharya, which is located on the banks of river Periyar, is the headquarters of the University. Apart from the Main Campus at Kalady, the University has regional centres at Payyannur, Koyilandy, Tirur, Thrissur Thuravoor, Ettumanoor, Panmana and Thiruvananthapuram

2. COURSE OFFERED

The University offers Part Time P.G. Diploma in Journalism and Communication (PGDJC) at Main Centre, Kalady.

3. ELIGIBILITY FOR ADMISSION

Eligibility for admission will be degree of this University or a degree recognized by this University under 10+2+3 pattern with not less than 45% marks in aggregate. Relaxation of 5% marks will be allowed to candidates belonging to socially and educationally backward communities. SC/ST candidates need to have only a pass in their degree examination. Those students who have appeared for final semester degree examination in April 2017 are also eligible to apply for the programme, on the condition that they should produce the Provisional Degree Certificate by 31.08.2017.

4. SELECTION PROCEDURE

Admission shall be based on the performance of students in an aptitude test.
